This month we are taking a look at a large artwork recently placed up on a residents house that was so well received by the owner and their neighbours.

The work in question is located at the corner of Chesham Road and Chesham Crescent and features a richly coloured and striking collaboration between London based artist Thisone and visiting Parisian artist Nush Poke. In this work each of the respective artists fused their distinct individual illustrative driven styles so harmoniously, with Nush Poke's distinctly characteristic bird taking centre stage whilst surrounded by Thisone's grey-scale flowers and both back-lit by a powerful glow radiating through some clouds. We love how the two artists have made such great use of this split wall section and made it meet so harmoniously.

It's really fun to see this wall come together from either side on your approach until you meet the middle for perfect alignment.

This painting marks the fourth time Thisone has painted about SE20 for the project and the first time Nush Poke has painted about the area and they really left something beautiful over the course of a gloriously sunny winter weekend.
